Queen of Peace supports Catholic education faithfully. Alleluia! Catholic education is a central pillar of Christ’s cause on earth. The Holy See teaches us that the work of Catholic education comes from the very heart of the Church (*ex corde ecclesiae*), and that, just as there are marks of the

Church proclaimed in the Creed – one, holy, catholic, and apostolic – there five marks of a Catholic school:

A Catholic school should be inspired by *supernatural vision* so that it keeps a purposeful mission;

The Catholic curriculum should be founded on a Christian understanding of man and mankind (*Christian anthropology*);

A Catholic school should be rooted in *communion and community*, which means regularly approaching the sacraments and regularly relying on each other as members within the body of Christ, all working to accomplish a shared mission;

Students at a Catholic school should be developing a *worldview that is distinctly Christian*, as opposed to whichever worldview just happens to be common;

The Catholic school should be sustained over the long haul by the energy and purpose of its *gospel witness*.

We do what we do for Queen of Peace Catholic School – in financial support, volunteering, teaching and organizing, and more, because of how true Christ’s call is upon everyone, because of how much good it accomplishes in human hearts and societies, and because of what beauty it inspires in the works of man.

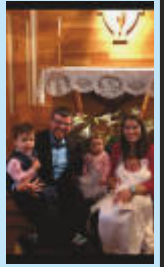
