

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



MATER DEI APOSTOLATE IS RELOCATING TO QUEEN OF PEACE!

A few weeks ago, I mentioned the possibility of Mater Dei Apostolate relocating to Queen of Peace. We can now officially say it is a reality beginning this fall, 2023!

What is Mater Dei?

"Mater Dei is a Catholic lay apostolate committed to the education and formation of high school students in South St. Louis, Carlton, and Pine County. Our hybrid education program provides coursework, resources and support for high school students under the Magisterium of the Roman Catholic Church. We work with parents to form students intellectually and spiritually, drawing on the rich tradition of our Catholic faith to guide us. *Our mission is to provide higher education prep with a higher purpose: union with God.*"

"At Mater Dei Apostolate, we believe in a classical approach to education. Classical education is the cultivation of wisdom, the inculcation of virtue, and the training of affections through meditation on the good, the true, and the beautiful. It fosters in the individual a "great love of learning and an even greater desire for God". It is an education for eternal life."

It is important to note that Queen of Peace Parish is NOT starting a high school. Mater Dei is a separate entity from Queen of Peace Parish and Queen of Peace Catholic School. Queen of Peace will NOT be financing Mater Dei and will NOT be financially or legally responsible for Mater Dei. Mater Dei would simply rent five unutilized classroom spaces in the lower level of Queen of Peace Church.

What a blessing and opportunity we have here! Pre-k through 12th grade Catholic education is available right here at Queen of Peace.

- The classes are in person with qualified Catholic instructors, but students are technically home schooled and therefore, they play on their local public-school sports teams and other extracurriculars.
- Classes are Mon-Thursday. No Friday class!
- School day will begin with Mass every day.
- Students may be fully enrolled or take only one or more classes.
- Because of the lean expense model, wider support of the community, tuition is very affordable.
- There are currently a number Queen of Peace parishioners teaching at Mater Dei. There a multiple Queen of Peace parishioners, including myself, on both the Governing Board and Advisory Board of Mater Dei. And Mater Dei already has a number of students from Queen of Peace parish.

As I spoke about informed consent last Sunday regarding how we receive Communion. I want to take the same approach. Please get to know and understand Mater Dei Apostolate. Speak to me or someone else about Mater Dei. We will also have an informational meeting in the next few weeks. Get all the information and discern how you want to approach your child's education. You may decide to continue what you were doing and that's fine. But I want you to consider Mater Dei and therefore be able to have informed consent and make the best decision for your son or daughter.

Mater Dei will require the support of many people. I ask you to consider investing your time, talent, and treasure in Mater Dei and so making Catholic high school education a reality for our young people.


