PASTOR'S REPORT



My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

A Blessed New Year to all of you. On January the 1st, we celebrated the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God. What a wonderful way to begin the year celebrating the gift of Mary in our life knowing of how she trusted in allowing God to lead her and brought Jesus into the world.

This weekend, we continue our Christmas celebration with the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. This is a feast that celebrates the revelation of God incarnate (Jesus Christ as fully God and fully human). The Gospel speaks of the three magi who were led by His star and travelled a great distance to do him homage. Just as how the magi were led by God which led to depart to their country by another way, we too are invited to trust in the gift of Jesus Christ who came to renew our lives and show us the way to the Father.

We will begin the remodel of the Blessed Sacrament Chapel that will relocate our Tabernacle so that it to be both visible and accessible in our Church as well as to have the Eucharist to be exposed in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel in the next few days.

We continue to pray for all those affected by COVID-19. We also continue to do our best to keep everyone safe. We have opened our Parish for meetings and for groups to gather. While the mask mandate of our city has been lifted, we have made available the left side of our Church for those still wanting to social distance. DEACON'S CORNER

Today's Host: Deacon Bob Hamilton

Matthew's details of the birth of Jesus provides us with a picture of Jesus' future. He tells us of the visit of the Magi. They were wise pagan gentiles in search of a Jewish king. Herod tried to get them to inform him of this infant king's whereabouts, so he could kill him.

Let's look at the wise men's gifts. One brought gold. Today, we continue to live by sharing our gold with the Jesus in others, except we call it sharing our treasure.

They brought frankincense. It was seen as a cure for different poisons and illnesses. Today, we use our frankincense as our gift of healing words of encouragement and support for those who need it.

They brought myrrh. It was used as medicine. Today, we are called to become a healing ointment in our relationships with others.

John told us that Jesus came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. Many contemporaries reject the following of Christ. They think it is odd for going to church and trying to see the face of God in others. Both Jesus' and our own rejections are painful.

May each of us have the passion of the Maji in reading the signs of the times, seeking the One who is the way, the truth, and the life. May each of us generously be an epiphany, a manifestation of our God to all others whose paths we cross on our journey through life.
