


#### FROM FATHER TOM'S DESK

**Discerning God's Call:** Today's feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the end of the Christmas season but the beginning of a time for us to reflect on our own baptism. Jesus has no need to be baptized, but submits to John's baptism as a part of his own discernment of the Father's call for his life. In Matthew, Mark, and Luke he heads from the waters of baptism to his 40 day retreat in the desert that we'll hear about on the First Sunday of Lent. Only after that will his public ministry begin.



The readings for the coming Sundays are full of invitations to consider our own baptismal call. Isaiah speaks about a God who shapes and forms each one of us in our mothers' wombs for a purpose. Over the next few weeks, we'll hear St. Paul's exploration of how we are all part of the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12). Each member of the Body has been given different gifts for the building up of the Body of Christ. The gifts are given for service, not for our own glory, and no member of the Body is better than another because he or she has particular gifts or hears a call to a particular ministry.

I have been impressed by how many of our young people have gone through or are going through a careful discernment of God's call for their lives. We usually have at least a couple young adults serving for Focus and NET Ministries. We give thanks to God that Ryan Glaser continues with his discernment of a call to the priesthood as he studies in Rome. God willing, he will be ordained a transitional deacon this fall, and ordained as a priest in May 2023. We were delighted to have a quick visit this past year from Sr. Felicity Heither (born Andi Heither) who is joyfully serving with the Dominicans. I continue to hear from young people who are asking great questions about whether God is calling them to priesthood or consecrated life or an area of ministry in the Church.

As we pray for those discerning their life-long call, remember that God never stops calling. Even for those of us who have served in a certain ministry for many years, God may well have something new in mind for you in 2022 and beyond, all for the building up of the Body of Christ.








#### **Adorers Needed!**


