**Open Wide the Doors to Christ...** I invite you to stay informed on the progress of our parish project both through weekly updates and information available on our parish website. Thanks to all who have contributed to the project—progress towards our financial goal is close and within reach. This effort of all of us will provide increased safety and accessibility to generations to come!

**Beauty in Christ Women's Conference...** Women of the parish will want to take the opportunity to attend the satellite gathering of this in our parish hall. I have found that, in order to grow in my faith, I need the support and encouragement of others. This will be such an event. See information about attending the conference at the St. Edward location in this bulletin. The January 29<sup>th</sup> gathering is just around the corner!

**The Christmas Season Ends this Weekend!** Among the liturgical seasons, Christmas is the shortest, but it is a bit longer than many think! This weekend, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, marks the official end of the Christmas Season. From the perspective of many externals (Christmas decorations, Christmas music, etc.), the holy season might seem to have ended before now, but it is the Baptism of the Lord that marks the official end of our Church's Christmas observances. Why the Baptism of the Lord? The baptism of the Lord in the Jordan River, commemorated this weekend, marks the definitive arrival of Jesus into his public ministry, and it is the clear beginning of Jesus' “public ministry” through preaching and healing. So, while the world may have moved on from Christmas, we make that move today—but only in a sense. For, we are always looking for Christ to be born again anew in our hearts, our Church, and our world, through his Spirit-given presence.

**The Adoration of the Magi...** which we recalled last week, continues in our world through the sacred work of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The same Lord, born in Bethlehem, is adored in the Blessed Sacrament, in our Cedar Valley in the Perpetual Adoration Chapel, located at Columbus Catholic High School. The chapel is open 24/7 for all to come and adore! Specific times where committed adorers are needed are Sundays at **1 AM** (once a month), Wednesdays at midnight, **2 AM** (once a month), and **3 AM**, Thursdays at midnight, **9 AM** and **3 PM**, and Fridays at midnight and noon. 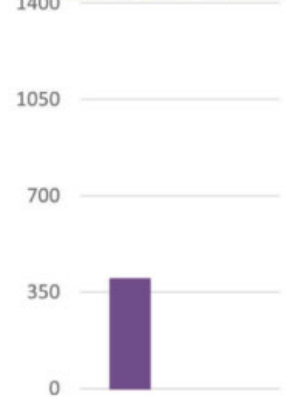
ST. JOHN PAUL II

- Though we are now deep into winter, the project continues! While the exterior landscape work has taken a "long winter sleep," work continues to design a retaining wall along Mitchell Ave, including the landscaping to make it a pleasant and beautiful sight for those who come to our parish. We are consulting with those who work to keep our parish grounds beautiful and forming a plan on how members of the parish family can volunteer to help with the new plants and gardens. Stay tuned!
- The old doors into the vestibule were removed and are being preserved for potential future use. Steel supports were installed to frame the new doors.
- The new concrete floor was scheduled to be poured this past week, raising the level of the vestibule to that of the sanctuary. Access to each set of stairs to the parish hall will be included from the new vestibule area.
