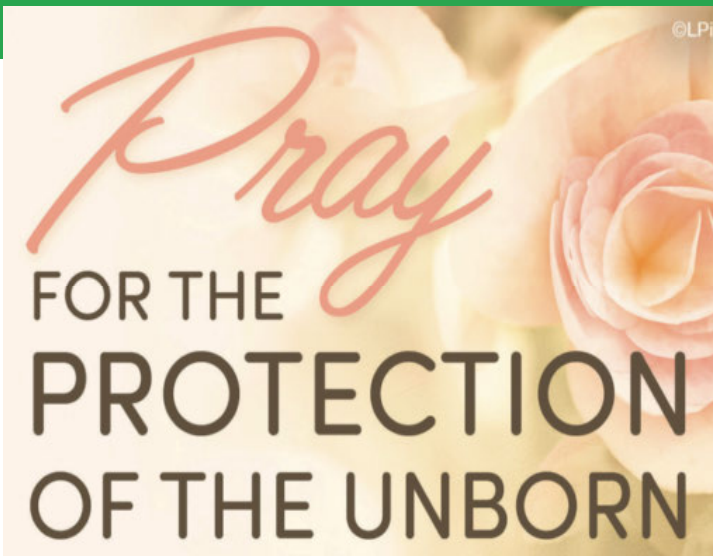

FROM THE PASTOR:

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25, 2022)—“We saw the star in the East, and we came to worship Him” (Mt. 2:2). This year’s scriptural theme, taken from the second chapter of the Gospel according to Matthew, comes from the account of the Epiphany. Each year in January, the Church recalls the visit of the Magi to Bethlehem, highlighting God’s invitation to all of humanity to a new covenant in the Incarnation of Christ. The unity of Christians finds its source and goal in Jesus Christ Himself, who came to be revealed to all of humanity! Inasmuch as each individual Christian is rooted in Christ and follows closely the teachings of Christ in his or her life, and inasmuch as groups of Christians do the same, in that way Christian unity is built. Our contribution to the fulfillment of Jesus’ final prayer, “that they may be one” (John 17:21), is our fidelity to Jesus Christ, by what we say and do. Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and fill them the fire of Your love—a love that makes us one.

Welcome to Megan McFadden! Megan joins our parish staff as Coordinator of Parish Life. Her responsibilities include the coordination of communication to our parish and the larger community and supporting various parish life activities. She will also be the first contact in the parish office—so make sure to welcome her when you might be in communication with the parish office.

Funeral Dinners: We are on target to resume using our parish hall for our families on the occasions of funerals. A time of gathering for a funeral dinner is so important as an occasion for others to have an opportunity to express by their presence and words support for those who are grieving. We have taken the opportunity during the hiatus to clean and repaint the kitchen area. For the sake of a more sanitary gathering, we will be using disposal plates and utensils for the foreseeable future. Thanks to those generous volunteers who have agreed to serve in the resumption of this important pastoral occasion of support by our parish family to our families who have experienced the death of a loved one.

First Reconciliation: A good number of our children experienced the beauty of God’s mercy in receiving the Sacrament of Penance for the first time this last week. As a confessor, I am always delighted by the trust and even joy with which our children approach this sacrament. They have much to teach us about coming with confidence and even happiness to the ever-merciful Father. Blessings to them as they continue their spiritual preparation for First Communion in the Spring!

Thanks to Fr. Solomon Farinto! Fr. Solomon, the chaplain at Mercy One Hospital, was most gracious to fill-in (at the very last minute!) for Masses last weekend at St. Edward when, upon my return from my father’s home in Michigan, I discovered that I had brought the COVID-19 virus with me! After the requisite period of quarantine, I’m happy to be back with you—while at the same time I am most grateful that this fine brother priest was able to provide ministry in the unexpected absence of your pastor.
