#### FROM THE PASTOR:

God's Healing Love: This weekend, you will be receiving a copy of the book In His Spirit by Richard Hauser, SJ. In his book, Fr. Hauser explores the truth that was first specified for Christians by St. Paul, who wrote in Romans 8:26: "In the same way, the Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself intercedes with inexpressible groanings." Each week, in the creed, we confess our belief when we say, "We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life..." While our belief in "God, the Father almighty" and "Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord" is definitely rooted in the life and teachings of Jesus Christ, the "Word made Flesh who has dwelled among us" (John 1:14), our belief in the third person of the Holy Trinity is rooted in the experience of believers, after Jesus ascended to heaven, who knew the Holy Spirit through His being sent into their hearts in a very real way. So...if we expect to understand and know about the Holy Spirit, an experience of the Holy Spirit is the way! While we certainly trust that it is the Holy Spirit that claimed us as God's children at our baptisms, was given to us in the Sacrament of Confirmation, and is the power that transforms simple bread and wine into the True Presence of Christ's Body and Blood in the Eucharist, we can also experience the Holy Spirit in a powerful way as Jesus promised, Continued →

when "two or three are gathered together" in His name. Such an experience of the Holy Spirit is the end focus of our Lenten study.

For, after having spent the season of Lent studying and reflecting upon the Holy Spirit, our parish's three-night mission, shared with Blessed Sacrament Parish, will be called "God's Healing Love." Led by the Missionaries of the New Evangelization from Texas, we will experience, through prayer and preaching, a vibrant and rich experience of the healing love of God in the Holy Spirit! I have personally attended three of these missions over the last several months and can testify that, inasmuch that we come and surrender in trust ourselves to the powerful love of God in the Holy Spirit, we will each know God's Spirit in a real and extraordinary way. So...as the season of Lent soon begins, we will seek to ask the Holy Spirit to lead us, by study and prayer, deeper into an experience of the marvelous Love of God.

In His Spirit Book Study Opportunities: There will be an opportunity, following each of the 8am Sunday Masses during Lent, to gather in small groups in the parish hall to discuss each week's chapter in the book. The discussions will focus on the questions at the end of each chapter. It is in discussing with other sisters and brother in the faith that we grow in our beliefs. No reservations are required—just stay after Mass or come before the 10:30am Mass (around 9am) and join the discussion! A second book study will take place each Thursday at 8am in the St. Clare Room in the New Life Center.

St. Edward 75th Anniversary Pilgrimage: "Great Saints Pilgrimage." You might recall that, as we headed towards the observance of our parish's 75th Anniversary in 2020 that we had planned to offer the opportunity for a pilgrimage to Italy. We all know what has happened to the possibility of international travel these last two years. The pilgrimage is finally going to happen: from August 29 to September 7, 2022. Jon Leonetti, noted Catholic speaker and radio host, and your pastor will be leading the pilgrimage to Rome and Assisi in Italy.
