

# Fourth Sunday of Lent — "Fall silent and return to the Father"

### FROM THE PASTOR:

Open Wide the Doors to Christ: While you will see more details about your parish's ongoing efforts to enhance the accessibility of our church, I want to comment on a question that has been posed to me on multiple occasions over the last few weeks. Having had the experience of worshipping at Blessed Maria Assunta Pallotta Middle School at Christmas, some have wondered if we're heading to an alternate location for Holy Week and Easter this year. The short answer is NO. Continued →

As with Christmas, you could have expected multiple communications by now if such a move was in the offingbut it is not. As it turns out, the project has progressed to such a point that, by Wednesday of Holy Week, the vestibule can serve as an emergency exit. You might recall that city code dictated that, without the possibility of an emergency exit through the vestibule, the other exits did not provide enough exit capacity (the experts call this "emergency egress") needed for a full church like we would expect at Christmas. Now, once a bit more work is done, the vestibule will be able to function as an emergency exit. So...when it is ready, we'll post signs on the new exterior doors indicating that they are able to be used only as emergency exits. You will also soon notice limited use of the balcony, primarily for live-streaming and for use of the organ. There will be a time soon when we will be able to use the balcony again for seating (once the vestibule doors can function as emergency exits), and we will be indicating this clearly with signage when balcony seating is possible. As with all construction projects, there could be variations on how we can use spaces from time to time, so be watchful of signage. It is our general expectation that, with emergency egress possible through the vestibule, there will be more opportunities to use our balcony again. Also, use of the lower-level bathrooms is on the horizon, again when emergency egress is possible through the vestibule. PROGRESS!

Agape Meal—You will see sign-up sheets at the exits of the church for our annual Agapé Meal, to be held during Holy Week on Wednesday, April 13, following the 5:30pm Mass. This ancient meal was held after the Eucharist, when the faithful would gather for a meal and an occasion to encourage one another in their faith (often under most trying circumstances that even led to martyrdom!). As part of our Lenten efforts to prepare spiritually for Easter, I invite all to attend this beautiful evening of song, readings, reflective presentations by three of our parish members, and good discussion. I hope you make the Agapé Meal a part of your spiritual journey towards Easter!

Parish Mission—Remember to put our upcoming Parish Mission (a joint effort with Blessed Sacrament Church) on your calendar—beginning at 6:30 pm on each of the evenings of Sunday, April 24; Monday, April 25; and Tuesday, April 26. The Mission will be led by the Missionaries of the New Evangelization and, entitled "God's Healing Love," will be an experience of healing by the Holy Spirit. I encourage all to trust that, if we come to the Holy Spirit, we will be treated royally by our most loving and merciful God! See you there!

Parish Hall Clavinova—The piano used for practices and events in the parish hall is really showing its age and is only marginally functioning. After becoming aware of the need, some generous donors have given funds to be designated for the purchase of a "Clavinova," an electronic keyboard—THANK YOU! As for the old piano, our technician tells us that it is in bad structural state—but if any of the parish family would like to have the old piano, please contact the parish office. Old piano, R.I.P.
