FROM THE PASTOR:

Easter is over...or is it? This Second Sunday of Easter, renamed by Pope St. John Paul II in the year 2000 as “Divine Mercy Sunday,” is in fact the 8th day of Easter, so that we say with faith that this day, and any day during the “Octave of Easter” is still Easter—for how can such a stupendous and monumental mystery as the Resurrection of Jesus be contained in a single day? So—today... happy Easter Sunday—and Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! The days leading up to our eight-day-long celebration of Easter, the Sacred Triduum, were beautiful celebrations of faith! *Continued →*

Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday all prepared us to proclaim “Jesus Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!” I certainly want to acknowledge the monumental efforts given so lovingly by the many, many folks who prepared the liturgies and then led the prayer—too many to be mentioned by name! I am equally grateful for all our people who gathered, to express their faith in large numbers for these very large days of faith. It was such an encouragement. In all things, we give God the glory!

As part of the new life of Easter, many noticed the “unveiled” **new vestibule of the church**. The “Open Wide the Doors to Christ” project has rendered a much more usable space that will serve us well. You may have noticed that “EMERGENCY EXIT ONLY” signs are posted on the exterior doors of the vestibule. Clearly, the space outside these doors and in front of the church is still a construction area, so we can walk across that area, for now, only in emergency situations. A development of the completion of much of the work in the vestibule area is that we now have safe access through the vestibule to both the balcony and the large men’s and women’s bathrooms below the vestibule, just off the parish hall in the basement. I have heard from some parents that, during the construction period, it was not always ideal to take their children to the front of the church during Mass, since it would be impossible to do so without the notice of just about everyone in the church! Of course, it brings us the deepest joy to have all our children at Mass, and I am particularly aware of the sacred work (and sometimes “hard work”) that parents expend bringing their little ones to church, especially when their children might be antsy, tired, or otherwise dissatisfied—and want to let the world know they are unhappy! Despite any expression of unhappiness, we welcome them and encourage you to continue this sacred (hard) work! So...the vestibule is now available if any of our little ones need a “break” (and maybe the little ones’ parents!) or need to use the restroom—now available downstairs by using the stairs in the vestibule. Thanks also for ensuring the children are safely guided to and from their “time-out.”

First Communion Sunday will be next week at St. Edward, April 30 & May 1. We expect children at each of the weekend Masses to be present to celebrate their first receptions of Holy Communion. It is a big and memorable day for them, their families, and their friends. So...let’s make sure to celebrate well with them—to produce lasting memories of the Eucharist as the foundation and beginning of a life-long trusting and participation in this “Summit” of our life of faith. We will have some extra guests with us—so let’s keep up our good work of showing welcome and hospitality to all of them! Our mission to be “an evangelizing community by faith, with love in hope” will be concretely before us next weekend, as we “speak” the gospel of God’s love through our hospitality to our children and visitors. 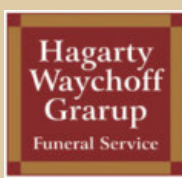
