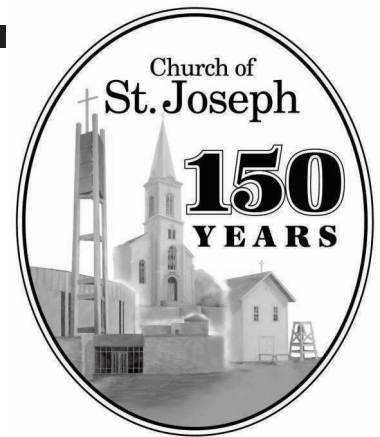

A Note from Father Notebaart

Last week Jesus invited a rich young man to follow him, but his wealth became an obstacle, for he was attached to his possessions. It was Peter who inserted his own commitment by saying: “*We have left everything to follow you.*” However it isn't long after this passage that we find Peter and his companions back fishing. It was the family business. So Peter's enthusiasm was softened by his reality: Commitment to Jesus had strings attached. The lure of his old life was strong.

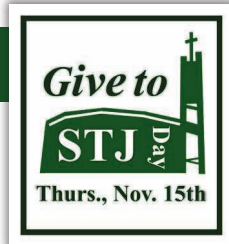
Today James and John, also fishermen, ask for places of honor when Jesus comes into power. That moment must have been a sad awakening for Jesus, for he realized that his disciples didn't have a clue about what his message truly represented.

Without anger, Jesus begins to teach the disciples that following him means not power but service. He draws out his own mission as one who stands at the margins where the people who were hurting truly live. Jesus immerses himself in those who feel lost, those who are rejected, and those who are outcasts.

The Kingdom of God is filled with these people, not those who cling to places of honor and power. They are nowhere to be found.

Do the disciples understand this? Probably not at this time! Are THEY among those who are saved? “Yes.” Even those who don't understand Jesus' message can be among the recipients of God's love, if they accept it and let God work within in them. Jesus remained with his choices of disciples in all their flaws. He had compassion on their lack of understanding, but he also saw their hearts were in the right place, even if they didn't understand him at the time. So they fought among themselves right up to the Last Supper. Today we call them “saints.” Why? Because they ultimately grew to understand their lives were transformed by Him.
