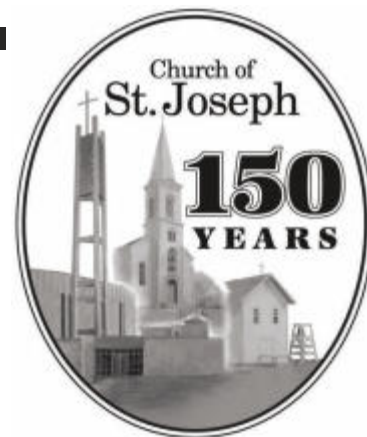
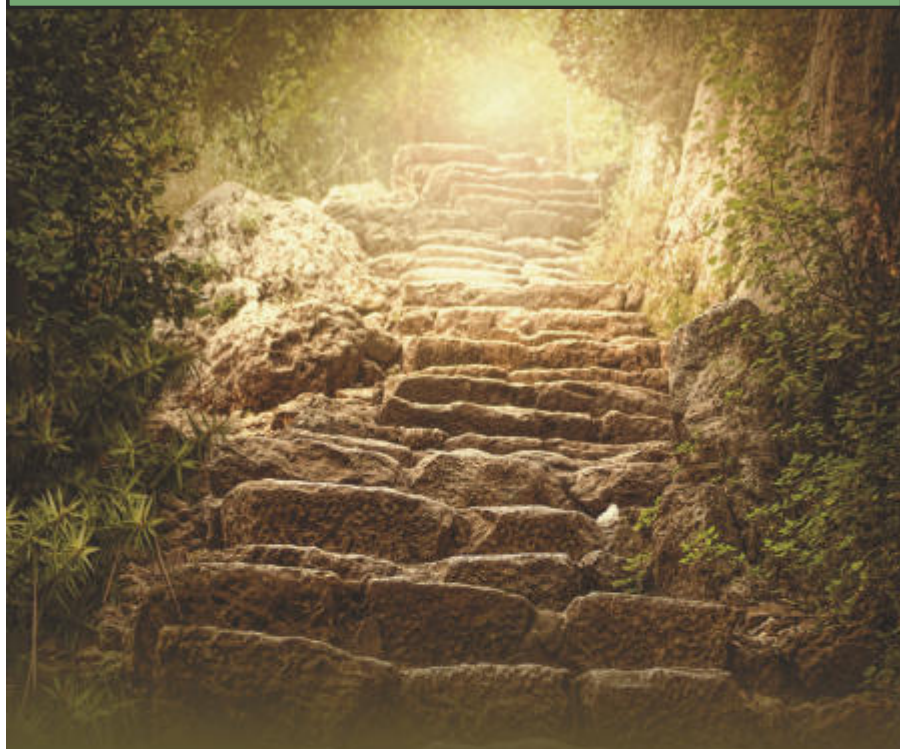

A Note from Father Notebaart

WE ARE MAKING OUR OWN SAINTS AS WE REMEMBER OUR DEAD — NOVEMBER 1, 2018

In February 1982, I lead the procession that brought the body of Brother James Miller into the cathedral. Brother James had been murdered in Huehuetenango, Guatemala. Years later I met Brother Paul Joslin who had been with him. During the days before the murder, the brothers had talked about leaving Guatemala. Their names were on a death list because they were protecting the children from the army. But they decided to stay. Brother James was only 38 when he died for the faith.

Father Stan Rother has family here working our fields. Ben Rother takes care of my animal food plot. I was talking to him one day and he said: "Oh my cousin is going to be a saint." Like Brother James, Father Stan's name was on the death list. His parish was Santiago in Atitlan, Guatemala. He too decided to stay in spite of the threats. He was killed on July 28th, 1981 at 46. His heart is buried beneath the altar.

When we remember our dead we are commending them to God, whose loving arms embraces us all, especially at death. Like Brother James and Father Stan, we bring our family before the altar. We keep the memories alive no matter how long they have been dead.

Our feast on November 1st at 9:30 AM and 6 PM marks our journey from death to life.

We are making saints as we remember.

Pope Saint John XXIII in his *Journal of a Soul* said: "At the beginning of my eightieth year I must hold myself ready: for death or life, for the one as for the other, and I must see to the saving of my soul.

Everyone calls me "Holy Father," and holy I must and will be."

Come to the feast of heaven and earth!

in the **Entryway** and at the **8th Street Entrance** through **Sunday, Nov. 11th.**

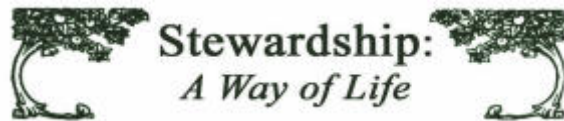
