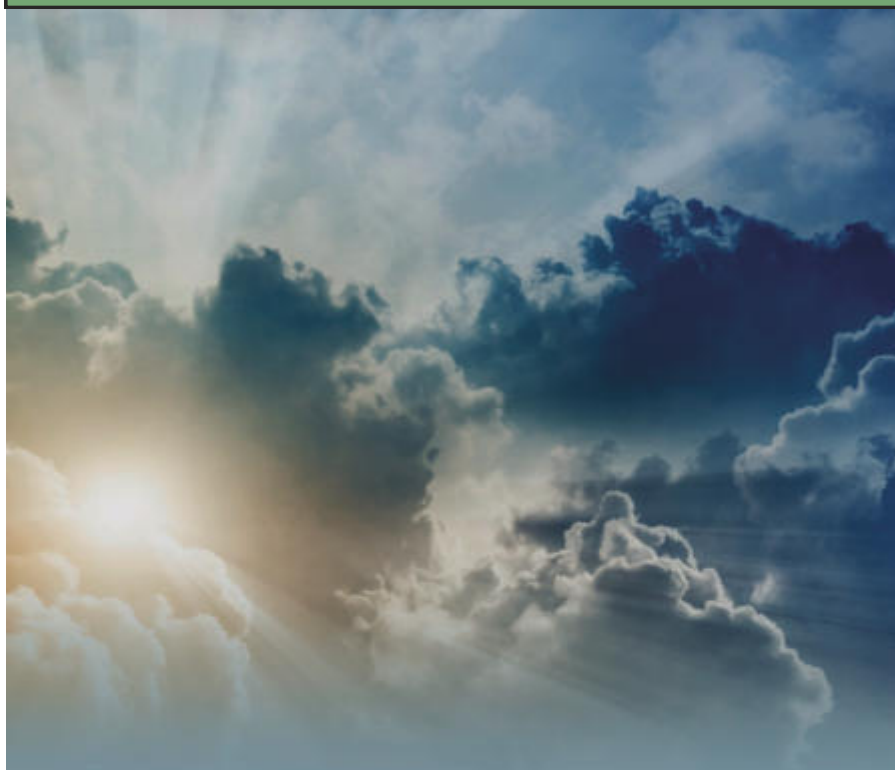

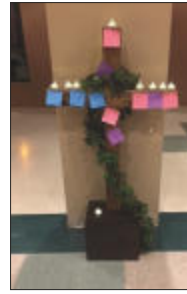
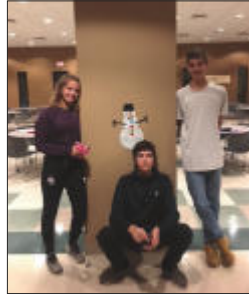

## Knights of Columbus

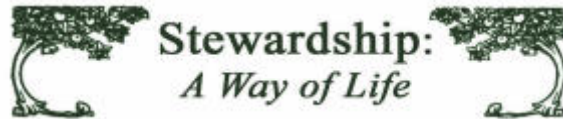
