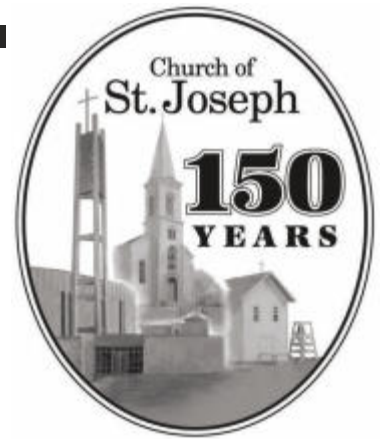

## Season of Lent: 2019

This week, we begin our **Lenten Journey** on:  
**Ash Wednesday, March 6th,**  
with **Service of Ashes** (no Mass)  
at: **9:30 AM** and **6 PM**.

### **Lenten Prayer Schedule:**

**Lenten Weekday Mass** is held at **9:30 AM**  
**each Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.**  
(If there is a *Funeral*, then no *Mass* that day.)

**Stations of the Cross** are **each Fridays** at **5 PM**,  
followed by a simple **Soup Supper**  
at **5:30 PM** in **Holy Family Hall**.

### **Fasting and Abstinence:**

Everyone who has reached **age 14**  
must **Abstain** from eating **meat**  
on **all the Fridays of Lent**.

All those **18 and older**,  
(until the beginning of their **60th** year),  
are to **Fast** on **Ash Wednesday**  
**and Good Friday**.

Only **one full meal** is allowed these days.  
Two other **meatless meals** may be taken according to  
one's needs.

Eating between meals is **not** permitted,  
but liquids are allowed.

This **Obligation** *does not apply*  
to those whose health **or** ability to work  
would be seriously affected.

Our **Community Penance** (as in years past)  
is to remove all **Salt Shakers** from our tables  
and no **extra salt** ... is to be used in cooking,  
**except** where it is **required**  
for the success of the recipe.

**Then**, come **Easter Sunday**,  
we will **bless** and distribute **Packets of Salt**  
so that you can return **Salt** ... to your tables  
for your **Easter Dinners**.

**St. Joseph's Church Bell** will *ring*  
each **Friday** at **3 PM**.

This is the **day and time** which **Tradition**  
believes that **Jesus died on the Cross**.  
Let the **ringing Bell** serve as a reminder  
to be **merciful** to others (and ourselves).

**The Church Environment Shift** from ...  
**Ordinary Time** to **Lent** will take place  
**tomorrow / today (Sun., Mar. 3rd),**  
beginning at **2 PM** in the **Church**.
