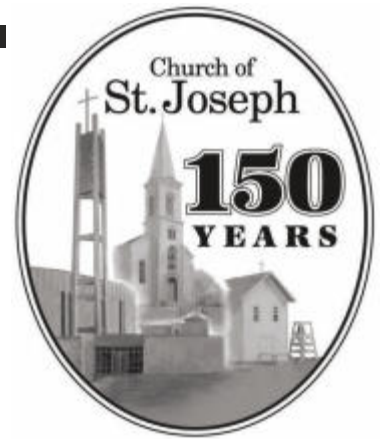

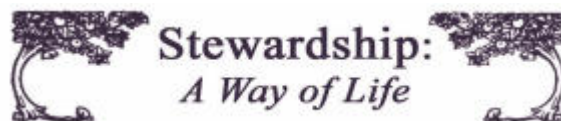
Easter Baskets
