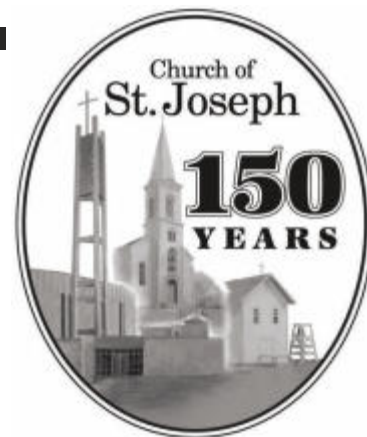

# Holy Week: 2019

## *Your Help is Needed!*

1) **Eucharistic Ministers for Holy Thursday** are needed to assist with:

- the Washing of Feet
- the Preparation of the Altar
- and the Distribution of Communion during the **Holy Thursday Mass**.

**Note:** **Eucharistic Ministers** for this Mass **arrive** at **7 PM** for a **brief training**.

2) **Environment Set-up for Easter:**  
**Holy Saturday, April 20th (next Saturday)**  
at **9 AM**

Many Parishioners are needed to help *transform* the **Lenten Environment** ... *into* the **Easter Environment** in **each** of these **Set-up Areas**:

- *decorating* the Cross on the Plaza & Church Doors,
- *preparing* the Entryway & Name Tag Tables,
- *staging* the Baptismal Font, Paschal Candle, Easter plants near the Cross in Center Aisle
- *placing* flowers in the Sanctuary, and more!

These **tasks** are very **simple** ... and **each** of them will take **about an hour or so**.

## **Vigil of "Keeping Watch"**

(Honoring Jesus' time in the Tomb)

On **Good Friday** (after the **7:30 PM Service**), the **all-night Vigil** in the **Chapel** begins, concluding at **Noon** on **Holy Saturday**.

In **one-hour segments**,

Individuals, Couples, and Families **pray** before the **Blessed Sacrament**.

## **Fasting and Abstinence:**

Everyone who has reached **age 14** **must** **Abstain** from eating **meat** on **all** the **Fridays of Lent**.

All those **18 and older**, *until* the beginning of their **60th year**, are to **FAST** on **Good Friday**.

The **American Bishops** suggest that we also **FAST** for **World Peace**...one day each week during **Lent**.

To **FAST** means: **eating** only **ONE full meal** that day.

**Two other meatless meals**,

(sufficient to maintain strength), may be taken according to one's needs. Eating *between* meals is **not** permitted, but liquids are **allowed**.

This **Obligation** *does not apply* to those whose **health** or ability to work would be seriously affected.

And Remember: **No Confessions** are heard during **Holy Week**.

## **Good Friday Ecumenical Service**

### The **Good Friday** **Ecumenical Lenten Prayer Service**

will be held at **First United Methodist Church** at **Noon** with **Fr. Thomas** giving a brief **Homily**.

## **Listen for it!**

The **St. Joseph Church Bell** will **toll** on **Good Friday** at **3 PM, 33 times**. This is the **day and time** (the **Hour of Mercy**) on which (**Tradition** believes) **Jesus** died on the Cross and the number of years of which (**Tradition** believes) **He** lived.
