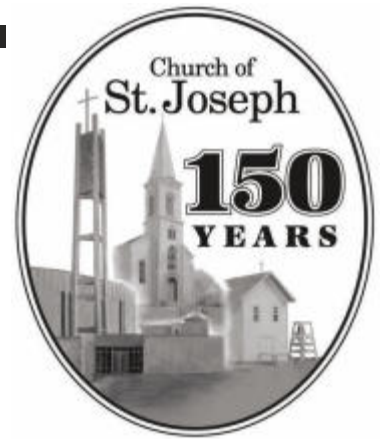

## Cavalry Cemetery

### Calvary Cemetery Information

#### Lot Rates:

The price per Lot is **\$1,050**.

There are a variety of sizes and prices  
for Cremation Burial Sites. A portion  
of the purchase price goes toward  
the Perpetual Care of the Cemetery itself  
(though not the Flower Fund).

#### Columbarium:

A structure of vaults above ground,  
lined with recessed niches  
for Cremated Remains.

The price for a single niche is: **\$1,500**

and includes: engraved name plate,  
birth year & death year,  
opening & closing costs.

#### Calvary Cemetery Flower Fund

ensures the placement of flowering pots  
on your Loved One's gravesite.

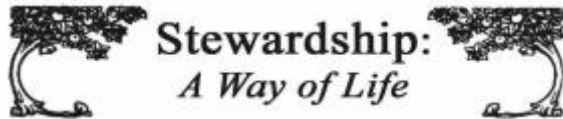
The one-time fee for the **Flower Fund** is **\$800**.
