Why a Lenten Creation Care Fast? Things we buy impact our environment, take time from our life and often control us. **WEEK SIX:** 24/7 consumerism exhausts workers, resources, and distracts us spiritually. Pope Francis urges us to seek a simpler, less materialistic life. Observing the Sabbath encouraged detachment from temporal goods by putting aside time for God. Try designating days this week for a more contemplative state, giving up buying "stuff," and pre-purchasing only the minimum essentials.

40 Days for Life

Join with us for a seven-day Jericho March beginning Monday, April 4 - April 10th at 3:00 p.m. each day outside Planned Parenthood: 671 Vandalia Street, St. Paul, Minnesota.

Our Jericho March is done to mimic the biblical battle of Jericho (found in Joshua chapter 6). God told Joshua to lead the Israelites in a march around Jericho for seven days. On the seventh day, the walls of Jericho crumbled. This event is a modern day Jericho March around the highest volume abortion facility in the Midwest.

We will begin by marching around the block in silence once a day for six days. The seventh day, we will march around Planned Parenthood six times in silence and on the seventh time, we will make a lot of noise!
