

Pastor's Corner

Thank you for all the birthday cards, gifts, and prayers that you have given me this past week. You all made this a special birthday, and I am truly overwhelmed by the level of support you have given me. I probably will not be able to

send everyone an individual thank you. Please take this note as my appreciation and love for all of you! Please continue to pray for me and I will continue to pray for you.

There will be an informational meeting for baptized Catholic adults who have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation this Wednesday, July 27th at 6:30 pm in Putz Hall for those who are seeking to receive this Sacrament. Again, this opportunity is only for those who are already baptized Catholics, have not been confirmed, and are the too old for the high school program. For more information, please contact Deacon Chris Evans.

As was announced last weekend, Blessed Sacrament Parish is beginning the process of updating our HVAC (air conditioning, boiler, air handlers and control system) for the Church, Rectory, and Putz Hall. Our system is old (condensers from the 1960s), inefficient, worn out, and becoming more difficult to maintain. The entire system is at or past its useful life, so the time has come to replace it. This problem has been studied by Finance Council, Pastoral Council and Modus Engineering. A lot of work and some fundraising has already been done as of July 2022. Efficiency and reliability of the new system are high priorities. The project will be quite expensive, estimated at \$750,000-\$800,000. We are starting a three-year capital campaign to raise as much money as possible up front. We will borrow the remainder from the Archdiocese of Dubuque. We want everyone to support the project, whether financially or indirectly. Extensive information is already posted on the parish web site for those who want to know as much as possible. We are planning a Town Hall-style meeting in person and will broadcast over livestream to discuss and answer questions. If you have any questions, please feel free to speak with myself or Amy Johnston in the office. Or you are welcome to speak with Pat Colwell, Steve Kennedy, Greg Greco, Teresa Ballantyne, or Lisa Rolinger of the HVAC Fundraising Committee. Have a great week!



Capital CampaignHVAC Replacement

We are pleased to announce that Blessed Sacrament has begun a Capital Campaign to raise the funds necessary for replacement of our aging HVAC system in the Church and Rectory.

As the original systems were installed in the 1960s, most of the equipment is at or far beyond its expected life. The increasing costs to maintain the current system, its reduced efficiency, and the risk that parts or accessories required for



repair may no longer be available, have led us to conclude that we are in need of a wholesale upgrade to our system.

Blessed Sacrament has partnered with Modus Engineering of Des Moines to develop a comprehensive and cost-effective solution to our HVAC needs incorporating modern equipment and a digital controls infrastructure that will provide improved comfort, controllability, efficiency, and air quality.

As this project will be quite expensive, we have started this Capital Campaign to raise the funds needed to ensure we can enjoy reliable, energy-efficient comfort, no matter the weather, for many years into the future!
