St. John Vianney Weekend Mass Schedule Saturday (Vigil) 5:00pm and Sunday 10:00am Holy Family Weekend Mass Schedule Sunday 8:00am Merry Christmas and Happy Epiphany!

This weekend we celebrate the revelation of our Lord—in his baptism in the Jordan River. at the wedding feast of Cana in Galilee, and most especially in the visit of the Magi from the East. Traditionally, the feast of the Epiphany is celebrated on January 6, whatever day that falls during the week, for it is the true 12th Day of Christmas. Nowadays. of course, we celebrate the feast on the

Sunday after Holy Family Sunday in order to celebrate this great solemnity with the whole parish community.

As is often the case in the church's liturgical year, we extend the greatest feast days into an octave celebration for eight days, and sometimes we extend it beyond that for a whole liturgical season of its own. This we do primarily with Easter and Christmas in our current liturgical calendar. Every year, the Christmas season extends past the new year celebration of Mary, Mother of the Church, past Epiphany and to the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. These memorials encompass all of our Lord's early life and the beginning of his ministry.

The liturgical season of Christmas traditionally also extended even past the feast of the Lord's baptism. In the older calendars of the church's liturgy, the Christmas season extended for 40 days, all the way to the feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd each year.



When I was a younger priest having one of my annual meetings with Bishop Quinn, I met him at the bishop's house Winona in late January. As we sat down, I noticed that he still had his nativity scene still up, front and center along his living room wall. I commented on him still having the nativity scene up and he responded, "Of course, until February 2nd!"

For us as Catholics, it is a beautiful devotion to set up our Christmas trees and put out a nativity set so that throughout Christmastime we can contemplate the great mystery of our Lord's Incarnation. As much of the secular world moves on so quickly after the day of Christmas, it is helpful to our spiritual life that we continue to meditate on the mysteries of our Lord's early life for the whole season after Christmas day.

Understandably, Christmas trees might begin to shed all their needles and they may need to come down sooner. Yet preserving our nativity scenes and keeping them out until the celebration of the baptism of the Lord or even yet to the Presentation on February 2 can be a beautiful show of love to our Lord Jesus Christ for such a great gift as his dwelling among us.



## Reflexión Española

#### 2 de enero de 2022 La Epifanía del Señor



Aun en estos tiempos, la humanidad continúa buscando la estrella, esa estrella que muchas veces se pierde entre la injusticia, el odio y la discriminación. Sin embargo, hay que seguir el camino y alzar los ojos al cielo para encontrar el centro de su luz. "Levántate y brilla, que ha llegado tu luz y la Gloria de Yavé amaneció sobre ti (Isaías 60,1). La Gloria de la Manifestación de Jesús en su Evangelio y en la Eucaristía se hace presente entre nosotros en la Liturgia de hoy. El Papa Francisco nos explica acerca de la belleza de esta celebración. "La manifestación de Jesús, simbolizada por la luz: Levántate y resplandece, Jerusalén, porque llega tu luz; la Gloria del Señor amanece sobre ti". Él nos exhorta al movimiento, a no quedarnos ahí fijos como estatuas sin hacer nada.

También, nos explica sobre la participación de los magos del Oriente y lo que ellos representan. "Los Magos, venidos de Oriente, representan a todos los pueblos lejanos de la fe judía tradicional: se dejan guiar por la estrella y se enfrentan a un largo y arriesgado viaje; se postran ante Jesús y le ofrecen regalos simbólicos: oro, incienso y mirra; la búsqueda del Señor implica también la generosidad del corazón" (1/6/2019). ¿Qué le estoy ofreciendo a Jesús en esta etapa de mi vida? ¿Qué tipo de manifestaciones he tenido de Dios a lo largo de mi vida? Pidamos, en esta Eucaristía, que la luz de Cristo se manifieste en estos tiempos turbulentos y oscuros que experimentamos en el mundo entero. Sigamos vigilantes, caminemos por sendas nuevas, sigamos el ejemplo de los Magos. Ellos, regresaron a su país por otro camino.




## St. John Vianney/Holy Family Parish News and Community Events


