May the peace of the newborn Christ child be with you all,

With this Sunday of the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, the Christmas season comes to an end. However, we can continue to celebrate the Incarnation, the birth of Jesus Christ until the fortieth day after Christmas, which is February 2. You can keep your decorations up in your home and lights until that date if you wish. February 2 is the Feast day of the Presentation of the Lord in the temple, also known as Candlemas because of the blessing of candles that takes place that day along with a procession into the church with lit candles. This commemorates the entrance of Jesus the light of the world into the temple as he was brought in by Mary and Joseph for the ritual purification. When Simeon took Jesus into his arms he prayed the Canticle that says, "Now Lord, you may let your servant go in peace; your word has been fulfilled. My own eyes have seen the salvation which you have prepared in the sight every people, a light to reveal you to the nations and the glory of your people Israel." Jesus is a light that reveals God and his plan to all the nations as we are finally able to see God when we look upon the face of Jesus.



I was planning to send Christmas cards to thank you for all the gifts given throughout the year, but I was not able to due to becoming ill during the Christmas season. So thank you to everyone for your prayers, gifts, cards and expressions of support throughout this year, for my birthday, my 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Priesthood, and for Christmas. May God bless you and bring to completion the good work he has begun in you. Thanks especially for your prayers as I continue to keep you in my prayers and ask God's blessing upon you and your families in this new year.

During the month of January, we as parishes are being invited to participate in the **Synod Gatherings** which are taking place in all the parishes/clusters in our diocese. Pope Francis has called for this special gathering in order to allow the Holy Spirit to speak to us in a new way and give us greater direction in moving forward as a Church. The sessions, to which every baptized Christian is invited, are going to be held on Thursday January 13 at 6pm at St. John Vianney Church in Fairmont, or Thursday, January 20 at 6pm at Sts. Peter and Paul Church in Blue Earth. You can choose either one to attend. Please invite another person to come with you. The Synod is not an occasion to ask to change the teachings of the church or to have a "gripe session" but rather to listen to the Holy Spirit as he speaks to us in prayer. It will begin with a period of quiet prayer and meditation before the Blessed Sacrament as we ask the Lord to reveal to us a deeper awareness of how he is calling us today to hear the gospel, to proclaim the good news to others, and how to travel together on the journey to salvation and eternal life in the midst of the challenges and troubles we face in this world.

The three sets of questions include reflecting on our experience of being part of the Church and being in communion with Jesus and others, how we are asked and able to participate in the Church's mission, and how we are being called to reach out to others and bring them to a closer relationship with the Savior, Jesus Christ, including non-Catholic Christians, and non-Christians. There will be a discussion of these questions and the fruit of our prayer reflection at each table with the responses being written down. They will be shared with the whole group, then compiled and sent into the diocese. The diocese will compile these discussion notes from all the parishes and write a report to the US Conference of Catholic Bishops. They will then compile all these reports and send a summary on to the Vatican along with the reports of all the Bishops' Conferences throughout the world. These will form the basis for the Synod of Bishops and other theologians in 2022-2023. Please pray for the grace of the Holy Spirit to renew our Church and give us a new desire to proclaim the gospel and bring people to Jesus to receive his healing, forgiveness and salvation! 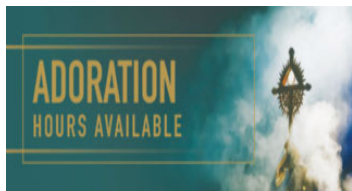

## *Reflexión Española*

9 de enero de 2022  
**El Bautismo del Señor**



Con la celebración del Bautismo del Señor se da por terminado el tiempo de Navidad. El Bautismo de Jesús es como una nueva epifanía, es decir, una nueva manifestación de Dios por medio de Jesús ahora en el Jordán. *“El Espíritu Santo bajó sobre él y se manifestó exteriormente en forma de paloma, y del cielo vino una voz: Tú eres mi Hijo, hoy te he dado la vida” (Lucas 3,22).* La revelación del Padre se manifiesta proclamando a Jesús como su Hijo.

El Papa Francisco en una de sus catequesis lo muestra en tres puntos muy importantes para todos los que hemos sido bautizados en Cristo Jesús: *“Jesús quiso recibir el bautismo predicado y administrado por Juan el Bautista en el Jordán. ¡Cuánta humildad tiene Jesús! Y al hacerlo, manifestó lo que hemos celebrado en Navidad: sumergirse en el río de la humanidad”.* Jesús, va con todo a lo que refiere la cuestión humana, menos en el pecado. *“El Evangelio subraya que Jesús, apenas salió del agua vio rasgarse los cielos y el Espíritu que bajaba hacia él como una paloma. El Espíritu Santo descende en plenitud sobre Jesús para darle la fortaleza de cumplir su misión”.* Por medio de nuestra vocación es que tenemos nuestra misión en la vida. ¿Cómo la estamos cumpliendo? *“La fiesta del bautismo de Jesús invita a cada cristiano a recordar su bautismo”.* ¿Sabes, o recuerdas la fecha de tu bautismo? Hay que preguntar sobre ese día y de cómo se celebró la fiesta de hacernos hijos e hijas de Dios. (Papa Francisco 1/7/2018).

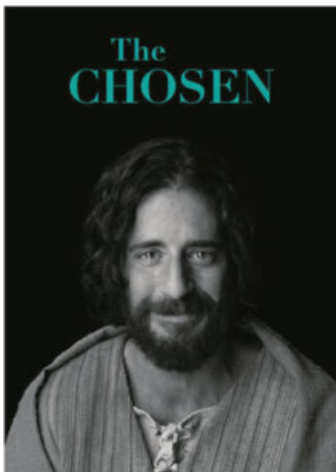


### St. Vincent de Paul – Helping Friends in Need
