

### **EDINA CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

Construction on Eden Avenue continues, and, with favorable weather, the project is moving along quicker than anticipated! Currently, our permanent driveway has re-opened, and is accessible via Arcadia Avenue and Normandale Road.

Beginning Monday, May 16, Eden Avenue will re-open from the West via Vernon Avenue. The intersection between Arcadia Avenue, Normandale Road, and Eden Avenue will be closed to all traffic. The main driveway off

Eden Avenue will continue to be an entrance-only route, with all exiting traffic being directed to Normandale Road, Southbound to Benton Avenue.




