PRAYER



Before Jesus ascended into Heaven, he said to his disciples, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold I am sending the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Inour first reading, we also heard, "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." When we are baptized, the Spirit of God comes upon us. We are clothed in his Spirit and his power protects us. Baptism means "to be fully immersed in." In baptism we are clothed with the power of God.

Clothing identifies people. Many professions wear uniforms, and we identify them by their clothing. Medical professionals, law enforcement, and military all wear uniforms. It's in this way that we can identify them. God provides us with spiritual clothing. When we go out into the world with our spiritual clothing, we are putting on Christ (Gal. 3:27), putting on the "armor of light" (Rom. 13:12), and being clothed with God's power (Luke 24:49).

Baptism clothes us in God's armor and gives us heavenly power. It is our ministry to go about doing good and making Jesus Christ known and loved, for he loves the world. We can share the Gospel with those who need healing, both physical and spiritual. Being clothed with the Power from on High allows us to minister to others, help them heal, and deliver them to God. God has clothed us in his power and love. Let us go forth to make Jesus Christ known and loved.




