Is not hunger a condition in need of healing?

After the twelve apostles returned from the mission Jesus gave them to announce the Kingdom of God and perform healings, Jesus went to Bethsaida with them for time away from the crowd. I imagine this was an exciting time of retreat for the apostles to share with Jesus all that each of them had done and seen! Yet even though Jesus desired time away with them, the crowd soon followed. Perhaps expectedly, the apostles brought the most basic human need of food for the 5,000 to Jesus, and he instructed them, "Give them some food yourselves" (Luke 9: 13). I do not believe Jesus was trying to be uncaring or unkind when he said this; rather he saw it as an opportunity to provide both spiritual and physical healing. Jesus recognized spiritual hunger in the apostles because even after he had given them the power to heal, they lacked faith in their power to heal the crowd's physical hunger. Using 5 loaves and 2 fish, Jesus healed the crowd's physical hunger, leaving twelve baskets of leftovers, enough to heal even the twelve apostles' spiritual hunger.




