



Follow Me

This week's first reading and gospel provide two similar, but seemingly conflicting, stories. Before following their teacher, Elisha and a new follower of Jesus ask to visit their parents. Elijah grants the request and Jesus says, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." Why is Jesus sterner with this follower than Elijah was with Elisha?

Before we focus too much on the differences of these stories, let us remember what is the same. Elisha, the follower, and all of us are all called to be holy and to follow Jesus – completely. He doesn't just ask for a piece of us, but all of us and our entire lives.

Now when we say "Jesus, that wasn't fair," let us remember that while our call to follow Christ is the same, each person's journey with Christ is unique. Each journey and stage are met with a different word from our Lord. Sometimes we need the 'tough love' of the Gospel story, and at other points, Jesus knows that we need time to heal or transition before we take our next step.

Wherever we are on our journey with Christ and His Church, remember what is the same - that we are all called to give our lives fully to Him. Whether at this moment it is easy, scary, difficult, or timely, know that He will always care for us on the path ahead. He is patiently walking beside us.
