


Mission Statement

PONDERING THE MORSELS

[A look back on last weekend's homily by Deacon Glenn] From Sunday, May 7th, 2023

This weekend's homily time by Deacon Glenn was of a different nature than usual. Our first reading was from the Acts of the Apostles, telling of the calling of the first deacons of the Church. Deacon Glenn informed us of an area of discussion presently going on in the global Catholic Church's *Synod on a Synodal Church*. Although we are very aware of our own archdiocese's Synod taking place, it's important that we also realize the global discussions taking place in the Global Church's Synod, which was called by Pope Francis in hopes of modeling a different way of being church together.

Among the various topics being discussed around the world in the synod, the matter of the possibility of female deacons has arisen. This past October, the Vatican issued a document entitled, "Enlarge the Space of your Tent," a title gleamed from Isaiah 54:2. This document compiles Synod input from dioceses all around the world. Six of its paragraphs are titled, "Rethinking women's participation," which among other things encourages the exploration of a female Diaconate.

Although we might find this discussion surprising, it's actually not new. The issue has been discussed in various forums for years now. But now, because of the public nature of global Synod, the conversation has reached new levels. Where this will lead is unknown, of course. But, it's worth some prayer and study by all of us.


