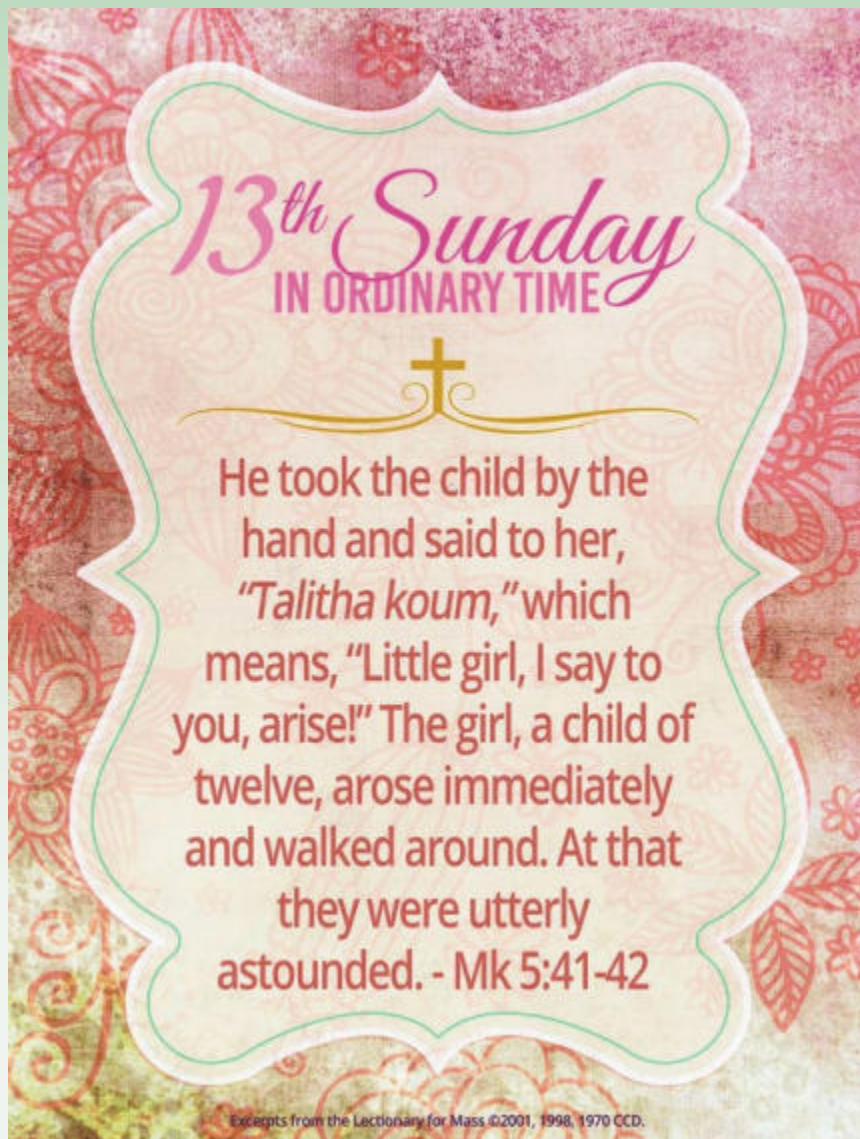

Pastor's Corner

Reconnecting after Social Distancing



Even before the coronavirus pandemic forced people into months of sheltering in place, social isolation and loneliness were serious health concerns. Both physically and emotionally. A study in the journal "Perspectives in Psychological Science" found that loneliness can have the same effects on your health as smoking 15 cigarettes a day.

Staying connected through social media and participating in the liturgy online have been beneficial, no doubt. But many still experience a disconnectedness through a past lack of face-to-face human interaction.

Step Out of your Covid Zone and Reconnect Get moving.

I myself have experienced a bit of Covid fog over the past year and a half. I need, perhaps you need as well, more oxygen-pumping exercise. Call up one or two friends you trust have been vaccinated, and go for a walk. In a few weeks, perhaps a hike. Not only will the companionship decrease past stress and lift spirits, being in nature boosts your mood.

Join a film or book club. Find a group that's been meeting virtually, and bring it outside to a park. Or start a new one yourself. My advice: pick movies or books that aren't heavy topics.

Learn a new skill or hobby. In the early days of the pandemic, baking bread and sewing masks became wildly popular. Some dusted off a musical instrument or second language. Now is the time to play with others, or talk with others. St. Bridget's has a dedicated group of crafters who love to get together once a week, and walk while they work ... with a lot of their handcrafting done between gatherings in our Crafter's Room. Volunteer. Our liturgical ministries are opening up, and are in need of a lot of volunteers as lectors, acolytes/servers, sacristans, ushers, ministers of welcome, ministers for hospitality at more and more events, donut coordinators, media volunteers. Our pastoral care ministry, prison ministry, and re-emerging justice and charity ministry will need many more volunteers. Please call the office, and connect with those who can reconnect you.

15. I often tell folks who've been away from liturgies and church-sponsored gatherings that the best way to meet caring, trustworthy people today is through our parish. In mid-August, we'll celebrate reconnecting at our weekend Masses. And we need you to personally invite parishioners, school alumni, children and grandchildren and other family members or friends to celebrate WE again. More info to come.

However you choose to get reconnected, be sure to follow safety guidelines. Continue to wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content. (I've a feeling we'll be doing this for many years to come.) And follow city and state guidelines for use of masks. New Covid variants are emerging in the U.S., and we don't want to experience more disconnection.

So reconnect more and more. Safely. At St. Bridget's.
