## Sunday Reflection

Today, Jesus asks the disciples a deeply personal question: 'Who do you say that I am?' Peter answers for the group by proclaiming, "You are the Christ." Peter and the other disciples began this journey as ordinary people who were called from their everyday labors to follow in itinerant preacher. During their time with Jesus, they have sat at his feet as he proclaimed the good news that the kingdom of God has drawn near, watched as he healed those who are ill, and witnessed him casting out demons. Their discipleship is based not on a printed set of beliefs, but on their relationship with the Lord. This is true for each of us as well. Christianity is not about following doctrines or adhering to a certain set of rules; Instead it is a covenant relationship with the Lord of life. Throughout our lives of discipleship, our own answers to this question "Who do you say that I am?" will change. At times we might know Jesus best as the one who performs orders in our own lives, or perhaps as the great teacher who words bring wisdom. At other times Jesus will be the comforter who walks with us in times of grief, or perhaps the counselor who calls us to forgive and grow. We live a communal faith that is also deeply personal. Each of us must answer for ourselves, who do we say Jesus is and how do we live out this belief with every moment of our lives?

### FAITH SHARING FOR FAMILIES

Everyone's lives have difficulties and struggles. We all have things we worry about and things that make us sad. God is always with us in our sadness and struggles.

Having deep spirituality doesn't matter if we do not make sure that our neighbors have food and shelter. Our acts matter absolutely.
