Today is the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time. We heard the story in the Gospel of the wedding feast at Cana. This reminds me of my Holy Land pilgrimage. We stopped at Cana in Galilee and Fr. Todd

renewed the wedding vows of all the married couples in our group. We also took time to browse the many gifts shops and then we took part in a five-course meal in the evening. It was a very exciting day and of course, we needed to celebrate with wine. Many of the couples purchased a bottle of wine to bring home with them and I believe two or three couples actually sent a case of wine home to celebrate with family and friends later.

Family is the root of our society. A man and woman united by the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony following God's plan of creation. One of the joys of being a Deacon is being able to celebrate the Sacraments of Baptism and Matrimony. Take time each morning, and hold hands as husband and wife and say the Lord's Prayer, asking our Heavenly Father to be part of your marriage and family throughout that day.


