Much like returning from the cold, as we set aside our parkas, gloves too numerous to count, foot gear to trip over, scarves, stocking caps, caps, all needed in triplicate, the warmth of a hot drink settles us.

The comfort of home reappears, our journey ongoing as we settle into the chair, soft and comfortable, allowing for meditation, mediation on God's world, as amazing as it is, the challenges never ending. And yes, even on cold snow, the warmth of Christ's love is felt, and with a slight tug, the joy of Christ embedded.
