It's just for old ladies and funerals, as many men so often say. What's that you ask? The Rosary.

Fact: Real men do indeed pray the Rosary. As Jesus expected His mother and disciple to remain in His love, so He expects you and I as well. For in today's Gospel, *"Jesus said: My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me"* (John 10:27). One powerful way to do so is to pray the Rosary.

"When Jesus saw His mother and the disciple there whom he loved, He said to His mother, "Woman, behold, your son. Then He said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his home" (John 19:26-27).

What better way to get to know Jesus and Mary, than for fathers and mothers to gather their children to pray the mysteries of the rosary (at least one decade of the rosary) for the intentions of marriage, family, and peace? Peace in our hearts, our homes, our parishes, our nation, and our world.

Just last Sunday (May 1st) Pope Francis specifically asked Catholics around the world to pray the rosary every day of this month of May for peace. He urged this request by asking a serious question: *"I wonder, along with so many anguished people, if peace is truly being sought…"*

So, what can each of us do to honor the Holy Father's plea? Well, we can begin to keep Sunday holy by coming to pray the rosary before Mass. You can also join myself and Deacon Kris/Deacon George on our Zoom Rosary (www.st-patricks.org) on Sundays at 7:00pm (link opens @ 6:45pm).

Here are some intentions to offer your rosary for this weekend: Let's all pray the rosary for our newly Confirmed students (May 5th), our First Communicants (next weekend), and the extraordinary gift of our mothers (living or deceased), and above all, for the gift and grace of peace that our world cannot give.

As we celebrate the gift of our mothers and honor Our Blessed Mother, we also recognize that Mother's Day can be a difficult holiday for many. We hope that the graces of our rosaries this month will provide you with a special opportunity to pray for more of Christ's love and peace in your own heart today.


