"1ST EUCHARIST: STARTING OUR PILGRIMAGE TO JESUS THROUGH MARY"

A pilgrimage is a spiritual journey to grow one's faith, virtue, and personal relationship in Jesus Christ. In most instances

pilgrimages involve journeying to a holy place or shrine. I've made many such pilgrimages in my lifetime, both domestically and internationally. They are all beautiful and unique, yet full of challenges since a life of discipleship (grace is not cheap) is never separate from the cross.

Yet I don't' believe I have ever walked for 21 miles (@ 9 hours), like I did last Saturday, to visit, for the first time, the only approved Marian apparition site in the United States: *Our Lady of Good Help*.

I am most grateful for your prayers for me along the way—Lord knows I needed them—and for the companionship and hospitality of Mike Vanness, his sister Mary, and their family, and four St. Patrick parishioners (Matt & Pam Harmon, Bonnie LaPlante, and Julie McGinley) who journeyed with us. My reason for doing so was to go to Jesus through Mary in union with St. Joseph to affirm and strengthen God's precious gifts to us of Priesthood-Marriage-Family-Eucharist here at St. Patrick's.

This weekend, 28 of our St. Patrick children will be starting out on the ultimate pilgrimage toward a more personal and intimate relationship with Jesus Christ, when they make their First Holy Communion. God's blessings to each of them, their families, and our instructors and catechists.

May this very special day be for our little lambs, our boys and girls, the first of many holy communions throughout their life. May it help to strengthen them in God's love, and their love for the Eucharist.

And may their parents and all of us here at St. Patrick's help to foster, by the regular practice of our faith (i.e. Sunday Mass, Confession, Adoration), a greater love for Jesus in word and sacrament, so that we may never, ever treat the Eucharist as merely a symbol, but the very Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, and the "Source and Summit" of the Christian life. O Lord I am not worthy!




