Bulletin Article 6th Sunday of Easter 2022 Hello everyone! It's hard to believe that it has been six weeks now since we

of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. The readings for Mass the past weeks since Easter are filled with God's love for us. Soon we will be celebrating the feast of the Ascension of our Savior into heaven next Sunday. I will be honest, I miss celebrating Ascension Thursday 40 days after Easter. Jesus returned that day to Heaven. He had fulfilled the mission of His Father. He came as a baby into a sinful world. As He grew into manhood, for three years He taught us how to live our lives-to love God and to love our neighbor as ourselves.

Even though Jesus is not physically with us anymore (in His is human form), the Holy Spirit is with us to guide us to the truth. He reminds us of the words that Jesus spoke to the apostles and continues to speak to us through Scripture. The Holy Spirit dwells in us and speaks to us in our heart, during our prayer time, and when we are open to receive His message.

In just two weeks, we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost -the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles. One of the favorite places on my pilgrimage to the Holy Land was being in the Upper Room where the Last Supper took place, the creation of the Sacraments of Eucharist and Holy Orders. The apostles waited in fear after the crucifixion of Jesus and then on Easter morning, Mary Magdalene came and shared the good news. Then after the Ascension of Jesus, they awaited the coming of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost with tongues of fire. You could just feel the holiness of this special place.

The Holy Spirit came to the apostles/disciples and poured out His grace upon them. The Holy Spirit comes to each one of us in the Sacraments we have received. He comes each day in the guietness of our hearts, with God's love and mercy. The Holy Spirit, the Advocate, longs to speak God's word to us and guide us—if we are open. Take time today and every day to listen, see, and feel the love of God in your lives! God is good—all the time!


