(Responsorial Psalm for Pentecost Sunday, Year C)

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, ST. PATRICK'S! You heard me right. Though today we celebrate the birthday of the Universal Catholic Church, since St. Patrick's is a part of the whole, it is our birthday as well. So, let's all celebrate another year of growing in discipleship, another year of asking the Lord to send us His Spirit, to renew the face of the earth in living more for Christ and others and less for ourselves.

Today we rejoice in Pentecost and bring to close "A New Creation: 100 Days to Grow in Holiness." A huge thank you and happy birthday to all our parishioners and staff who entered the journey with Christ from Ash Wednesday to Pentecost Sunday, from "I'm Broken" to I'm Free" to I'm Chosen."

Also, to all who took a leap of faith in giving a brief personal testimony before Mass (*Fan the Flame*), in sharing about God's love-mercy in their life, in the hope that all those who came fifteen minutes early to Mass each Sunday would be inspired by their stories, and be encouraged to share their own.

Our Heavenly Father is so gracious-merciful in first giving us His very being (love-truth) in the Person of His Son Jesus, *love incarnate*, and second, the *spirit of truth*, in the Person of the Holy Spirit, whose role is to encourage and strengthen us for lives of discipleship. Just as St. Paul says in his Letter to the Romans: For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!"

How can we all become more open-honest-generous to the gifts of the Holy Spirit in our life? One sure way is to be more self-aware of the four types of pride that prevent us from being more humbleobedient to the Holy Spirit, a prerequisite for friendship with God. The four types of pride:

Pride of Superiority/Authority
 Pride of Timidity
 Pride of Sensitivity
 Pride of Complacency/Vanity

Next week I'll go a little deeper on these four types of pride and the remedy for each. Until then, let's all celebrate our birthday by praying for the Holy Spirit to renew our life, our parish, and our world. Peace!
