"Is Belief in Christ's Real Presence [Eucharist] the Source & Summit of Your Faith?"

Last year the U.S. Bishops voted at their June meeting to author a document on Eucharistic Coherence, to restate for

the understanding of all the faithful the Church's clear and unchanging teaching on the Eucharist as the real presence of Jesus Christ and the "Source & Summit" of our Christian life. To foster our belief, the Bishops will commence a three-year catechesis on the Most Holy Eucharist this summer.

Recently, our former auxiliary Bishop—Andrew Cozzens—Bishop of the Diocese of Crookston, MN sent a decree (May 18<sup>th</sup>) to all the priests of his diocese expressly renouncing the custom in the Diocese of prohibiting the use of bells and incense during the Mass. Furthermore, Bishop Cozzens decreed that those who are able are to kneel after the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God).

Furthermore, the faithful are to kneel during the period of sacred silence after receiving Holy Communion and returning to their pew until the Presider (Clergy) is seated. Those unable to kneel are to be seated.

While the tradition of using bells to signify the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and the use of incense as an expression of reverence and the lifting up of the prayers of the People of God is a common practice, it's hard to imagine that a bishop would prohibit their use.

Such unfortunate practices are little ways in which belief in the Most Holy Eucharist as the very body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ is eroded among the faithful, leading to the false belief that the Eucharist is merely a symbol of remembering Jesus' death on the cross.

"If people don't go to Mass because they really don't believe in the Real Presence, then if people really did believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, wouldn't our churches be full?"


