### **BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS**

(OCT, JAN, APR, JUL) The general blessing of expectant mothers will be offered at all Masses on the last weekend of the month on a quarterly basis. Following the general blessing, mothers are encouraged to pick up a holy card for the patron of expectant mothers at the Blessed Virgin Mary altar. A personal blessing will be offered for any mother who desires it while at the BVM altar.

#### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Confessions held Wednesday and Friday, one half hour before Mass, Saturday from 3:30-4:15 pm and at the parish office by appointment.

### PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic Adoration takes place 24 hours a day in the Adoration Chapel.

## **MARRIAGE**

Contact the parish priest at least one year in advance to arrange marriage. No weddings during the Lenten season.

#### **BAPTISM**

Baptisms are celebrated the first Sunday of the month, following the 10:00 am Mass. A baptismal preparation program is required and parish registration expected. Contact the parish office for information and to schedule.


