A personal blessing will be offered for any mother who desires it while at the BVM altar.

### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Confessions held Wednesday and Friday, one half hour before Mass, Saturday from 3:30-4:15 pm and at the parish office by appointment.

### PERPETUAL EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic Adoration takes place 24 hours a day in the Adoration Chapel.

#### MARRIAGE

Contact the parish priest at least one year in advance to arrange marriage. No weddings during the Lenten season.

### BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated the first Sunday of the month, following the 10:00 am Mass. A baptismal preparation class is required and parish registration expected. Contact the parish office for information and to schedule.
