#### Greetings, my Christmas pilgrims:

We made it to the Manger! After four full weeks of preparation, we now rejoice in the reality of God becoming Man and entering our human realities. Christ knows our hearts, our lives, our families from the inside, from a nearness, a closeness beyond our deepest imaginings and longings. Jesus Christ is God with us!

To this we respond with hearts overflowing with gratitude: thank you God for coming to save us. Thank you for d bringing up back into relationship with you

seeking us out and bringing us back into relationship with you.

l extend this deep gratitude to each one of you. Yes - you - the one reading these words. Whether you were at the center of helping prepare our outreach, our celebrations, our liturgies, our environments or simply offered a small prayer for a loved one - I am grateful to God for you. Even if we never meet, know the tender love God has for you, placing Divine Life at the core of every family: that despite our weaknesses Jesus always brings hope.

As we mark this Feast of the Holy Family, the gospel wants us to realize and receive the truth that Jesus was part of a real human family. Yes, Jesus, Mary & Joseph are a family given as our model of holiness - but this is a Family that we can approach and reach out to and truly invite into the craziness of life.

We can often define "holy" as something untouched or apart from the trials of our fallen world - but the real gospel portrays something very differently. Mary and Joseph had to struggle to make it to Jerusalem for the annual Passover feast. They had to secure lodging (something that didn't go so well in Bethlehem!) and meals for extended family members. In the exhausted chaos of their return to Nazareth, Jesus gets left behind! If you've ever felt overwhelmed by family life, can you imagine leaving behind the Son of God?

Of course, God had his reason for this distress: to continue revealing to Mary and Joseph Who their Son truly was. In these Christmas days, God wants to do the same for us. That, with Mary and Joseph, we might ponder Who Jesus truly is for us in our time of prayer and with loved ones.

Let's continue to celebrate Christmas with wonder and joy!


