Jesus Christ is a Gift for All

Dear Friends,

As we continue our meditation on these Christmas mysteries, we come to the glorious revelation of Jesus Christ to all nations. Symbolized by the magi who spend great energy and desire to seek out God, we rejoice and wrestle with the reality that Jesus Christ is a gift for all the world. He is no one's private possession, but desires to be the fulfillment of every human hope.

The first words of scripture on this "Epiphania" of Jesus Christ come from Isaiah and express this hope:

Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you. See, darkness covers the earth, and thick clouds cover the peoples; but upon you the LORD shines, and over you appears his glory.

God reveals himself in progressive stages of human history, and in this New Year Jesus wants to pursue a deeper relationship with each of us.

Instead of the typical New Year's resolutions, perhaps we can resolve to more regularly ask challenging and yet life-giving questions.

For example: In this New Year, can I be more reflective about the real experiences of life, the day-to-day moments in which God wants to be discovered and discerned and responded to in faith, even when His language is not as clear as I would want?

Can I reflect on the word adoration (a word literally meaning "mouth to mouth," expressing affection): which people, or experiences, or achievements occupy my deepest energy and desire? Can I speak with God about these things? Can I find a space of silence or before the Eucharist to let God acknowledge and guide them?

As pilgrims together on this journey, I give thanks to be joined by your prayer and generosity and care for one another. May God increase this!

Finally, a big, big word of thanks to all those who made our Christmas liturgies and churches shine with the joy and glory of God! I am so blessed by all your efforts!

Coats for Kids Thank You


The Knights of Columbus appreciate all of the coats donated from our parishes. Over 80,000 coats were collected in all of the churches.


