

Beginning Again, with the Holy Spirit Dear Friends,

This first month of the new year offers many chances to "Begin Again" in our life with Jesus. That may take the form of spiritual resolutions, a return to work or school with renewed resolve to love boldly, but patiently - or perhaps asking the Holy Spirit to give us the eyes of mercy that St. Luke demonstrates in his gospel - the Gospel that we'll hear most in 2022 (Year C).

Following his temptation in the desert, "Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news of him spread throughout the whole region" (Lk 4:14). Jesus was going back to his roots ("He came to Nazareth, where he had grown up") to announce something new: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me!"

Are we capable of receiving something new, even as the continued effects of Covid stretch our souls and our societal bonds? Can we choose charity again each day, even as new Covid restrictions stir up exhaustion, resentment and blame? Can we ask the Holy Spirit - Jesus' very Life Breath - to renew us in this trial?

While he won't be guiding any NFL team to the Super Bowl this year, one former NFL quarterback, Philip Rivers, has a powerful testimony about "beginning again." Following a disastrous loss in college, Philip went to his priest spiritual director for advice and encouragement. The priest invited him to try an ancient, though little known, spiritual practice. It involved praying two words: "Nunc Coepi".

At first, Philip didn't know what those words meant. The priest translated the Latin, "I Begin Again". When you're defeated, discouraged, caught in a tornado of criticism, overwhelmed by life, do this: Stop, breathe in the Holy Spirit, and then pray "Nunc Coepi" - I begin again.

He's been doing it ever since: 17 seasons, over 60,000 yards and 400 touchdowns later, he's inspired many. That's all while raising 9 kids with his wife Tiffany: a beautiful testimony to life, as we pray this weekend for the end of Roe v Wade and protection of all vulnerable life.

And so we're presented this choice in the challenges of life: Do we say sarcastically, "Oh, here we go again!"? Or can we try to utter a new phrase, with a New Spirit, and allow something new to be born in us.

Nunc Coepi, my friends! May Jesus Christ and His Spirit, help us to Begin Again! Yours in peace, Fr. Scott


