

March for Life Events

Saturday, January 22 marks the 49th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision, the devasting ruling that wiped away laws protecting unborn children nationwide and has led to the deaths of more than 62 million babies.

Brainerd

The county March for Life will begin at the corner of South 6th St and Oak St in Brainerd at 11:30 a.m. and will end at the Crow Wing County Courthouse. Out of respect for the local businesses, please do not leave your car at the corner where the march begins. The march is sponsored by the Crow Wing County Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life (MCCL).

St. Paul

The Diocese will not have a bus going down to the St. Paul March for Life. However, individuals and families are encouraged to drive down on their own. There will be a prayer service for life at the Cathedral of Saint Paul at 10:30 a.m., with the march on the state capitol grounds beginning at 12:00 p.m. A pro-life program hosted by Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life will follow at 12:30 p.m. on the capitol steps. The program typically last less than 30 minutes.
