#### A Note from Our Pastor

We come to the end of our Christmas celebration this weekend, unless you are really hard core and celebrate until the Feast of the Presentation, February 2. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is a nice way of rounding out our celebrations. We have been focused on the coming of Christ, Emmanuel, God-with-us, to repair our relationship to God that we damaged by our sinfulness. The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord observes the beginning of Jesus' public ministry.

Baptism is also the beginning of the life of faith for most of us. When I am in St. Cloud I will often stop at the Cathedral and visit the font in which I was baptized. It is a beautiful reminder to me of the gift that my parents gave me when they brought me to that font. Each time we enter the church we sign ourselves with holy water which is also a reminder to us of our baptism. What a gift.

This week our young people received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. It is always special to spend some time with them and share God's forgiving love with them. One of the things that I share with them is that all of us sin. It is important for them to place their own sinfulness in the context of the human condition. We don't want them to think of Reconciliation as something that is a punishment for them but a special sacrament that God gives all of us to help us in our spiritual life. Have you taken advantage of the opportunity to celebrate the sacrament recently? Many of us go before Christmas and Easter. But what about other times of the year? How is our own awareness of our sinfulness an invitation to experience this love of God? Among the graces of the sacrament is strength to resist temptation. I find that true in my life. After Confession I do find that God gives me special graces to resist those temptations to fall back into old patterns. Not necessarily that it brings about a permanent change but that I do recognize that if I turn to God, God will respond.

Several years ago, I came across a wonderful poem by Howard Thurman. It captures beautifully the idea that what we have been celebrating should have an effect throughout the year. It is called, "The Work of Christmas." When the song of the angels is stilled,

When the star in the sky is gone,

When the kings and princes are home.

When the shepherds are back with their flock,

The work of Christmas begins:

To find the lost.

To heal the broken,

To feed the hungry,

To release the prisoner.

To rebuild the nations,

To bring peace among brothers,

To make music in the heart.

May this work of Christmas be at the heart of your life in the coming year.


