#### A Note from Our Pastor

This is the end of Ben Peter's two week residency in the parish. He will be back but I wanted to encourage your prayers for him and all our seminarians (especially parishioners Riley Becher and Nick Gawarecki). It has been a pleasure having him involved in so many areas of our parish life.

This week we began a series of adult ed and spiritual reflection based on Chris Stefanik's book, <u>The Search</u>. We gave the book out last Christmas and finally have an opportunity to invite you to delve into it more deeply. We meet either Sunday or Wednesday evening for about an hour. Even if you missed the first week it is easy to catch up by watching the first video on line through our FORMED subscription. Please check the parish website and bulletin for more information.

Our readings this weekend center on the beautiful story of the Wedding Feast at Cana. It is the third of the three Epiphanies (or manifestations) of the Lord. While the marriage itself is not the main point of the story it is an appropriate time to reflect on the Church's teachings about marriage.

The Church teaches that we find the meaning of marriage in nature. That marriage derives its definition from the goals of marriage which are written in nature – the continuation of the human race through the procreation and raising of children as well as the mutual care of the spouses for each other. No other human relationship has these attributes. As one commentator put it, "... society has established marriage and given special privileges so that children can grow into responsible adults and members of society."

Marriage is also designed to support the couple in their mutual love for each other. It is within a committed relationship that spouses can truly open themselves in trust to the other and give totally of themselves. We read in the U.S Bishops' document *Marriage:* Love and Life in the Divine Plan, "God established marriage so that man and woman could participate in his love and thus selflessly give themselves to each other in love. A man and a woman who by their act of consent are no longer two but one flesh (see Mt. 19:6ff) render mutual help and service to each other through an intimate union of their persons and of their actions."

In the final weeks of my mother's life we had to make the hard decision that she could not return home – and that was her fondest wish. Her care needs exceeded what we could provide and we were not able to find adequate home health care in our area. At 90, my dad could not continue to give mom the level of care that was demanded. As we discussed, and the tears flowed, my mother finally said, "If anything happened to him, I would never forgive myself. He's my everything." At the time I thought to myself – there is marriage that is truly a sacrament.

My parents' life was not an easy one. There were lots of ups and downs, triumphs and tragedies. Some of the things they experienced tore other couples apart. But because they opened themselves to the Lord as the center of their relationship, the grace they received on their wedding day continued to grow and bore beautiful fruit. That is my prayer for every couple whose marriage I witness. I love seeing the excitement and commitment the couple have for one another. Let us continue to pray for healthy, happy, holy marriages.

#### SYNOD 2021 - 2023

Pope Francis has called for a Synod in 2023. He has asked his Bishops and the people of their Diocese to come together to discern where the Holy Spirit wishes to lead the Church in the third millennium. In order to do this, the Bishops have asked each parish to set up synod listening sessions to discern and answer some fundamental questions. Pax Christi will hold their synodal listening session on Sunday February 6. **Everyone** is welcome. The feedback from this listening session will be compiled and sent to our bishop at the end of February 2022.




#### **ROCHESTER ROSARY RALLIES**
