

Following Mass on January 30th there will be a meeting of second grade parents to discuss preparation for Reconciliation and First Communion.




The Young Adult Group (ages 21-35) meets the 4th Sunday of the month from 5:00 to 7:00 PM. Please join us for fun and fellowship.
