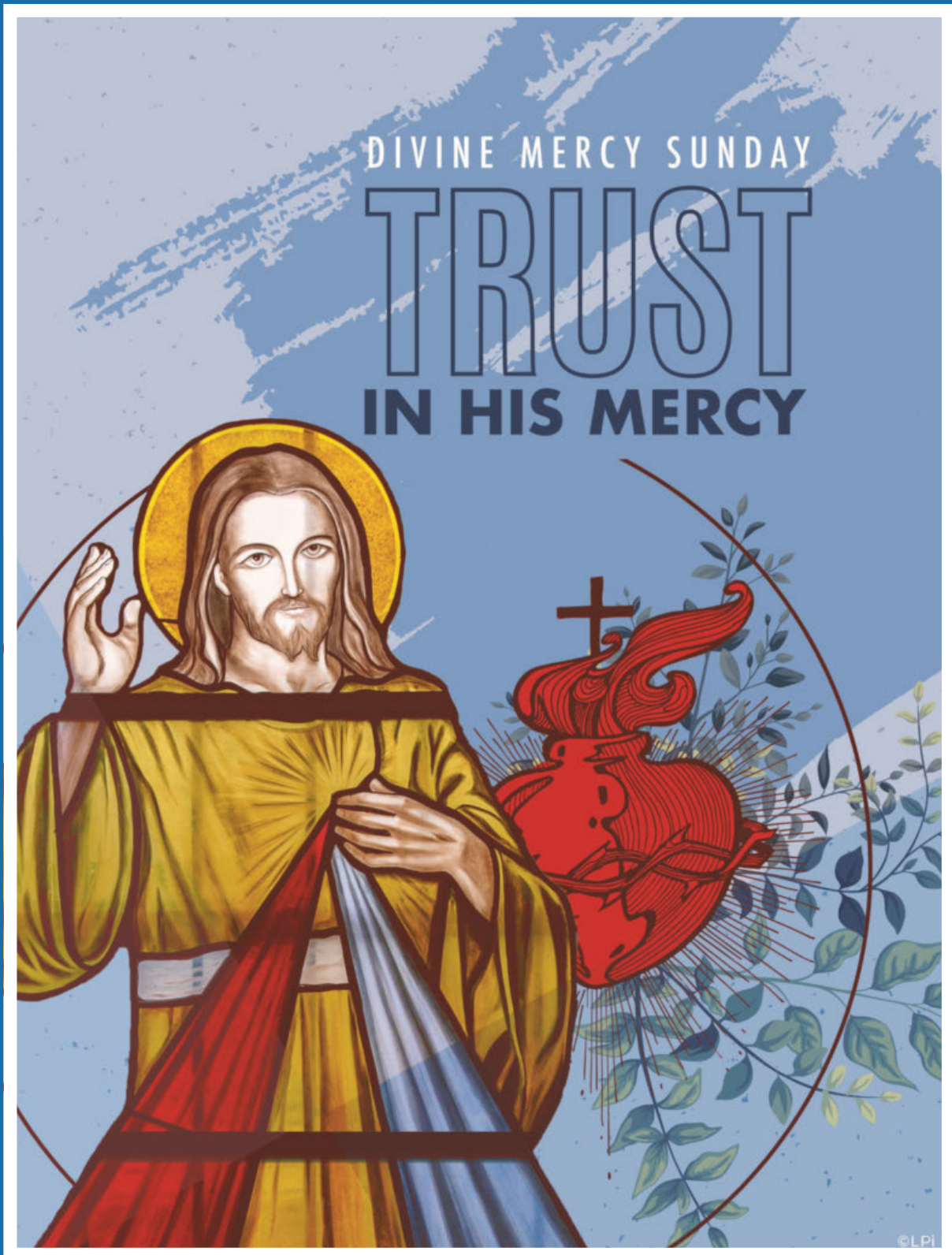

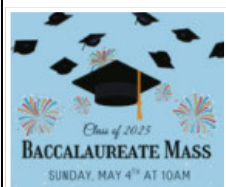

Mary's Meals – Feed the Children

During the month of May, the Social Justice Committee will be asking your help to feed children living in poverty in Malawi, Africa by participating in the Mary's Meals School Feeding Program. Through Mary's Meals, each child receives one bowl of fortified porridge each day in their place of learning which saves them from starvation and encourages them to attend and to stay in school. Southern Africa is suffering from the worst drought in 100 years making it impossible to grow crops and an estimated 21 million children in the region are suffering from malnutrition.

The goal for our parish is to feed 200 children and \$25.20 is all it takes to feed one child for an entire year!

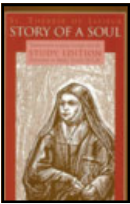

The next book the St. Pat's Women's Group will read together is *The Story of a Soul*, by St. Therese of Lisieux.

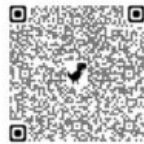
The version we will read is the Study Edition translated by John Clarke, O.C.D., which includes "Background and Context" and "Reflections & Questions" sections at the end of each chapter.
