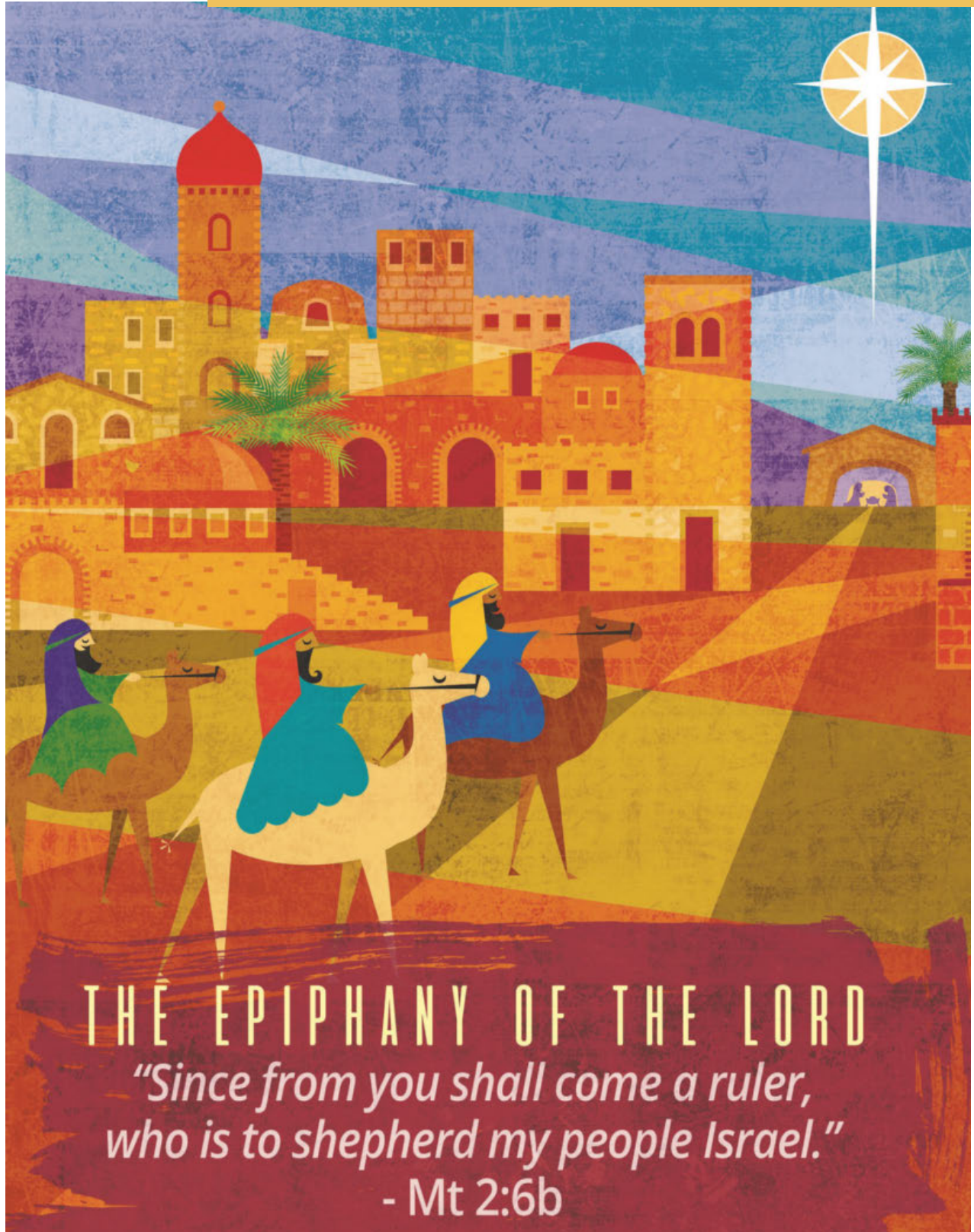

Happy Year of Our Lord 2022! Here are some big ways you can grow in your faith at the beginning of this year:

Join our Book Club and dive deep into the new book given to all our families at Christmas: **Rescued: The Unexpected and Extraordinary News of the Gospel by Fr. John Riccardo!** This book is “a big deal,” from Father Tom’s perspective, and he wants *everyone* to read it and understand it. Read it together as a family or with a group of friends, and use the discussion questions built right into the book. Let this book “marinate” in your soul. Chew on it. Wrestle with it. Pray with it. Lent is almost here, and it’s not too soon to plan ways you will prepare and repent for this blessed season. Marino will be leading us on a three-day retreat March 25-27, at Saint John’s. Please block off these dates on your calendar. You do not want to miss this once-in-a-lifetime

Extreme Faith Camp

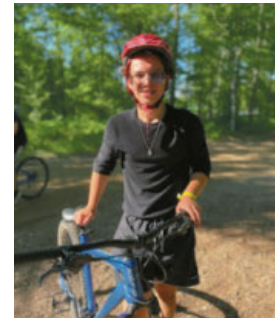

STEWARDSHIP CORNER



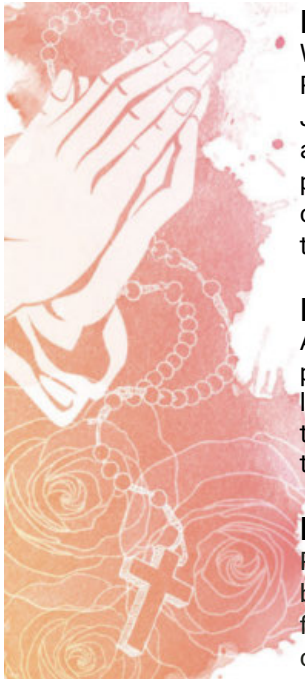
