All the priests of each deanery come together for regularly scheduled meetings, and one priest is elected by the deanery to represent them at the monthly presbyteral council which is led by Archbishop Hebda. The dean also is tasked in the installation of new pastors in the deanery when the bishops are not available.

Just like Fr. Joe, the deanery has elected me as the upcoming dean. There are not much day-to-day tasks of being a dean, but when a new pastor is being installed, I need to be present at the installation Mass. In the month of August, I will probably have 2-3 installation Masses I need to be at.

Additionally, Fr. Ralph Talbot, the pastor of Saint Mary of the Lake, is taking a well-deserved sabbatical this Fall. Archbishop Hebda has asked me to be the parochial administrator of Saint Mary's while he is gone along with taking on the role of being the moderator of Frassati Catholic Academy. This temporary assignment means I will be spending time at those campuses during the week as well. Please say a prayer for me and for more vocations to the priesthood as I take on these new responsibilities.




