Archbishop Hebda has asked me to be the parochial administrator of Saint Mary's while he is gone along with taking on the role of being the moderator of Frassati Catholic Academy. This temporary assignment means I will be spending time at those campuses during the week as well. Please say a prayer for me and for more vocations to the priesthood as I take on these new responsibilities.


BORN TO RUN 5K


