

St. Lawrence Parish Updates

- Sunday, May 30 following the 7pm Mass will be an Adoration/Praise and Worship night.
- We will suspend livestreaming Mass starting June 6, 2021. Our last streamed Mass will be Sunday, May 30 at 8am.

- Summer is approaching—What is appropriate for Mass? Appropriate dress should reflect three things; our respect for God's house, our respect for Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist, and our respect for our brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ. With this in mind, a guideline for men, women, youth and children should be no shorts or short skirts and no low cut tops or tight attire. Thank you for honoring God and one another!
- What is the significance of offering a votive candle? In early Christian times, we light a candle before a statue or sacred image of our Lord or of a saint. Of course, we do not honor the statue or the image itself, but whom that statue or image represents. The light signifies our prayer offered in faith coming into the light of God. With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition the saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord. The light also shows a special reverence and our desire to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart and go about our daily business. We have these candles available in the church with a donation box available. Each donation covers the cost of each candle.
- We have a dropbox for Sunday offerings on the outside confessional wall at the back of the church. You may also continue to slide them through the office window, mail, or set up electronically at umncatholic.org/donate. 
