Dear Friends in Christ,

When we began Lent this year, the Lord reminded us in the Gospel from Ash Wednesday to embrace the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These Lenten practices, meant to work in tandem, permit us growth in the spiritual life through self-denial, greater encounter with Jesus, and a spirit of generosity.

Part of living mercy in the Gospel is the reminder that as followers of Jesus, we are called to have a special love for the poor. The Lord does indeed hear the cry of the poor, and we must also heed their cry. There was tremendous support from our family of parishes for the humanitarian aid to the people in the Ukraine. Our parishes also support our annual mission appeal and take part in other charitable works.

We are called to be mindful of the poor both within our own community and within the world as a whole. Our parish has a vibrant St. Vincent de Paul society that helps people in our area in a number of ways. Our ability to assist people in need depends on the generosity of people to this program. While as a parish we do dedicate collections to this society, there is continued need.

In addition to providing food, drink, and clothing for those in need, we are called to be in communion with these people. Welcoming the stranger, visiting the infirm, and visiting those in prison remind us that although we might help a person with their particular needs, we must never lose sight of the person.

Please continue to reflect on how you are equipped to live this aspect of the Lord's own mercy during this Lenten season.

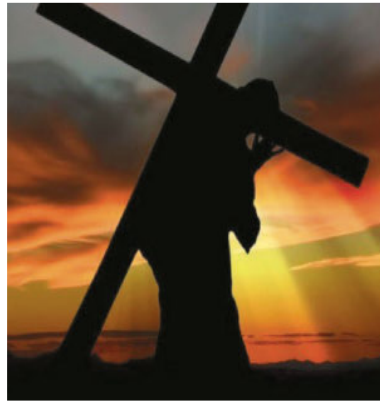

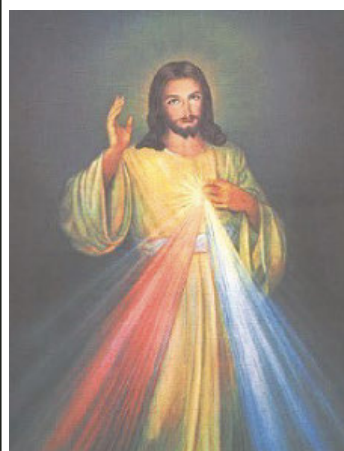
