When we began Lent this year, the Lord reminded us in the Gospel from Ash Wednesday to embrace the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. These Lenten practices, meant to work in tandem, permit us growth in the spiritual life through self-denial, greater encounter with Jesus, and a spirit of generosity.

Part of living mercy in the Gospel is the reminder that as followers of Jesus, we are called to have a special love for the poor. 


